But I know my Michael Nelson and he already has made me devour a zombie book (Valen the Outcast) which neither is my cup of tea normally. So I gave it a try. The story got me hooked immediately. David Reid is a Day Man,

a Sundog, a normal human being who serves one of the 50 Old Families as an employee. Because of an incident two of those families are at war and David is caught in a bloody feud, and suddenly nothing is as it seemed with a third and a fourth party participating in this dance. What makes the story fascinating is the mix of very down-to-earth problems of David with sophisticated exploitation of the vampire myth. I have not been familiar with the art of Brian Stelfreeze before, but he delivers dynamic pictures that already tell a story before you read the words. The only complaint I might utter is that he takes so much time for each issue that he produced only six issues in less time than two years until now. So it will take some more months till volume 2 can be out which I am awaiting eagerly. Highly recommended!
