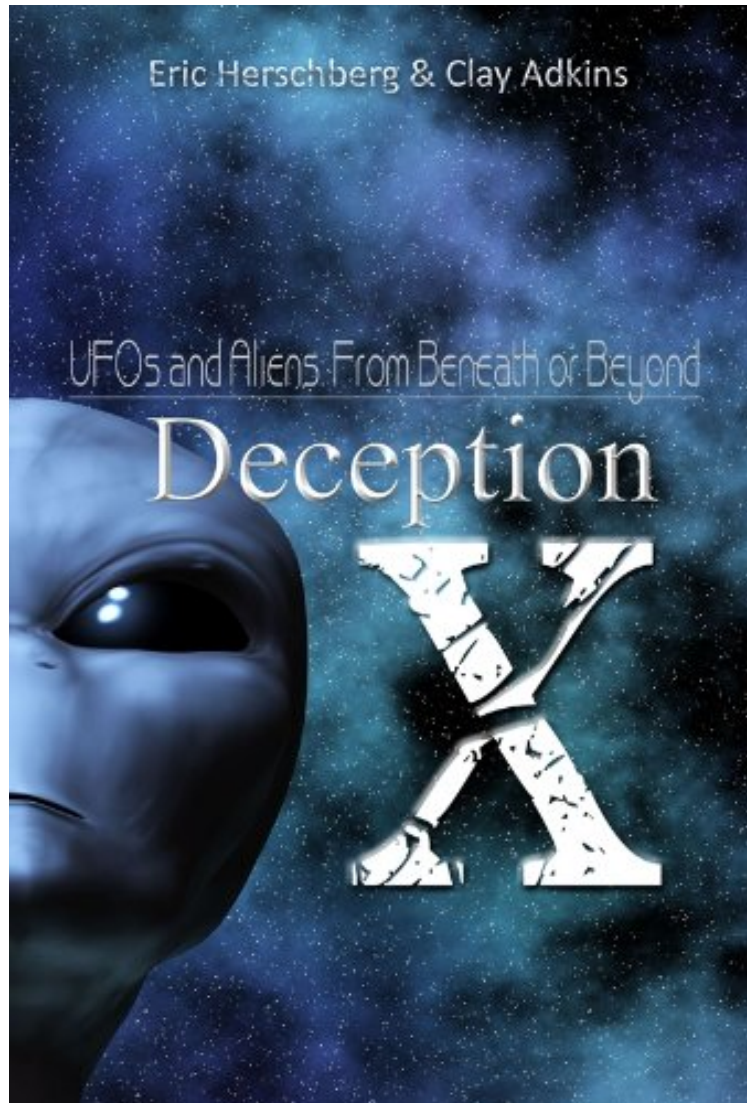

The author has made a good job in displaying the demonic nature of these so called aliens, and I think every reader can learn a lot from this book. Especially for this low price it's worth the money. After reading many books about this subject I miss a little bit of depth though. In some instances it seems like a good research has not been done. For example is he writing some things about the "mormons" which are not true, but which are common beliefs among some evangelicals.. For example does he write that mormons believe that salvation comes by their works. In truth, mormons believe that without the atonement of Christ, no one could ever be saved no matter how good and great his works are. Christ performed the greatest sacrifice of all, and he invited us to be like him. Trying to be like him means to follow him, to show our love to him by following his commandments. These things are what mormons consider as "works" and as James taught that "Faith without works is death" so can't we follow Christ without trying to be like him.. And to me it makes sense that those who follow Christ will one day stand differently before him than those who just believe but bring forth no good works which proves their sincerity.. Also, Joseph Smith never said about himself that he "did more for the salvation of men except Christ".. this is something John Taylor, a friend who was with Joseph when he got killed, said about him shortly after his death. It simply was the opinion of a close friend who felt strongly about his passed friend. In this manner there are certain claims and teachings which seem not deeply enough researched, but which seem rather looked at only from one side.
