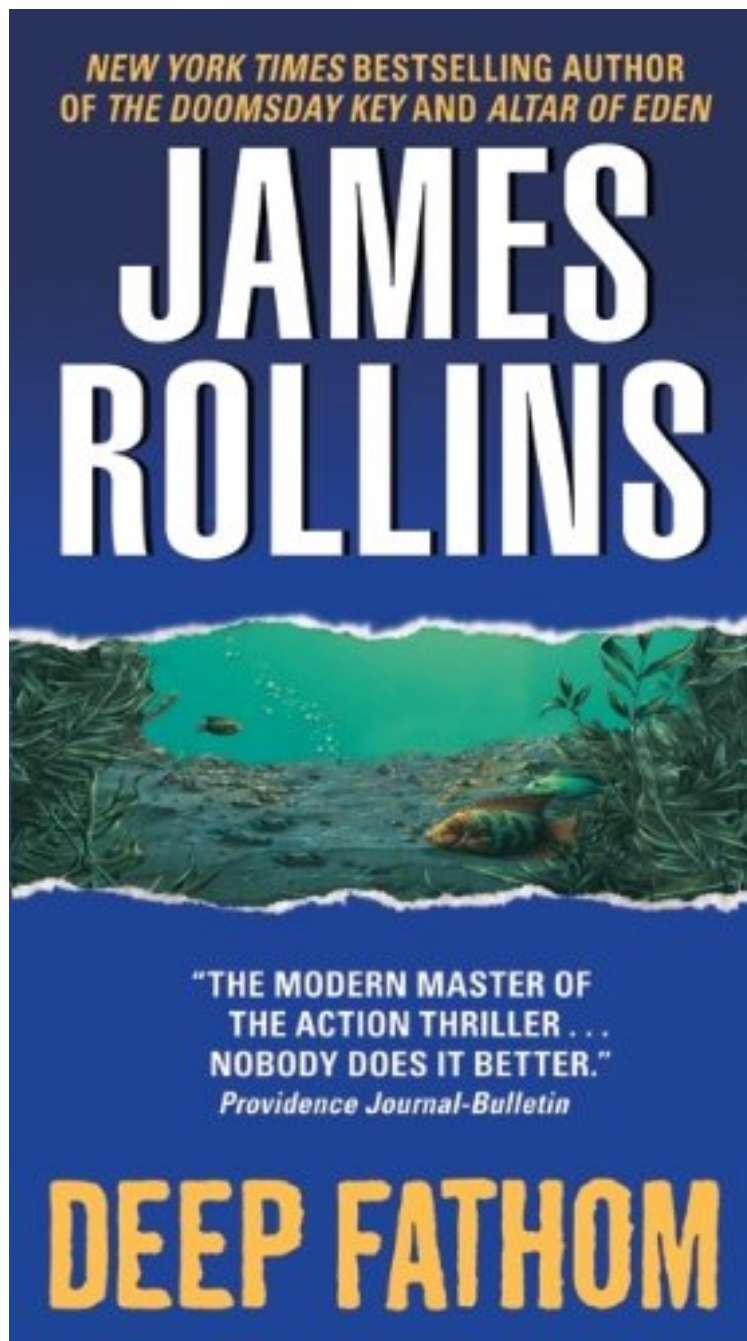

However, the German well-known Baron von Munchhausen is a poor amateur compared to Mr. Rollins's plot: Superwoman and superman, both extremely good-looking, extremely intelligent and young, extremely worked-out can and achieve everything: They fly with the spaceshuttle and dive in submarines, are perfect navigators, divers and shooters, fight with giant deepsea-octopusses and survive atombombs, know everything about ships, computers, artifacts, 12.000 years languages, martial arts, geology etc etc etc. It is too much to bear.... Above all, we peace-loving Europeans can't stand this repeatedly "America is the greatest nation in the world" " the most important man in the world (US-President) and this constantly worshipping of "fighting in Korea/Vietnam/Kuwait etc" and trying to attain the worldleadership.
