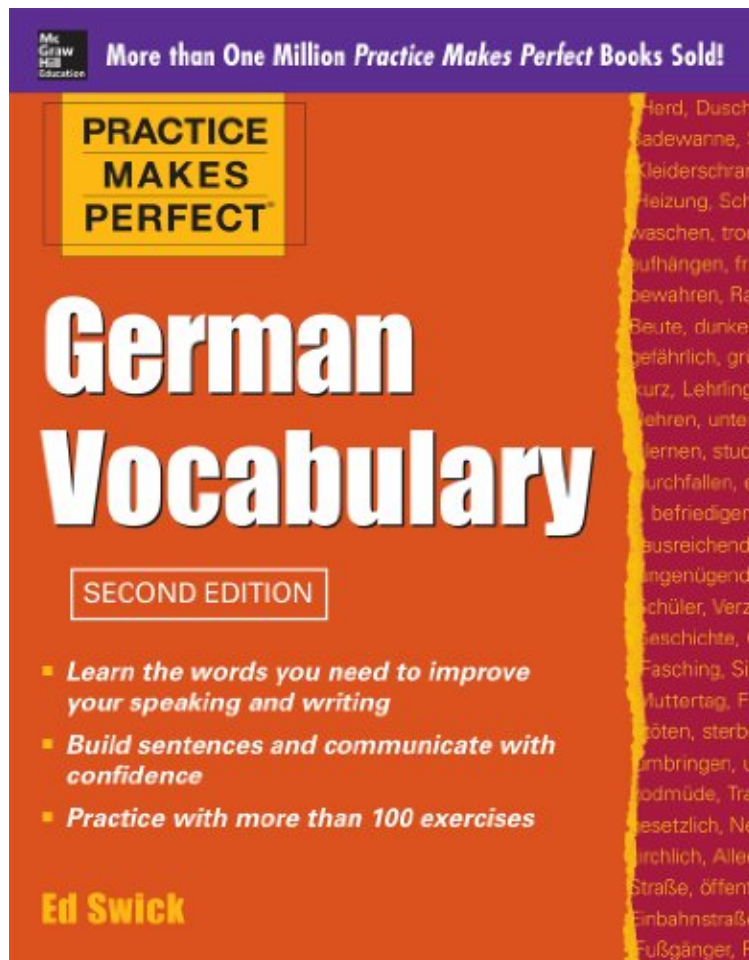

So I think translating this word as Landlord is quite a wrong context.
