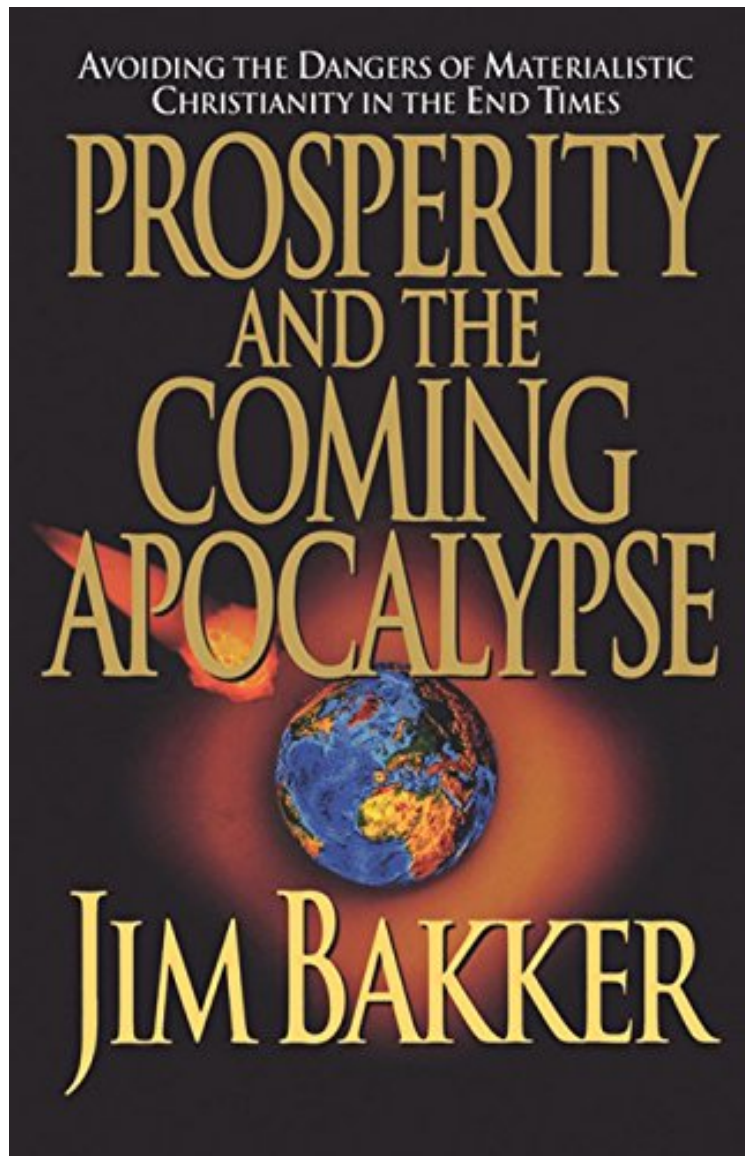

Not exactly what preachers preach when they want to keep everybody happy and comfortable and keep those pledges rollin' in! Jim Bakker has never been on my top ten list of Christians I look up to. Imagine my surprise, upon reading this book, to find that he has come to the same conclusions about prosperity and about the rapture/tribulation question that I feel the Holy Spirit has led me to through studying the scriptures.
