writing style is exciting - as was the story. So why just four stars for the last book? (Spoilers ahead!) Well, I was a bit disappointed at the end. The last book was not as good as the others. Fallon skipped the years too fast for my liking without explaining how Pete and Logan get used to their new life and their powers. I also didn't like the way some characters were somehow pushed aside, like Sorcha and Ciarn, Aoi, Kazusa, Isleen - and, at last, Hayley. Hayley's development to betraying her childhood friend was not convincing at all. The characters were well created as such and I loved almost all of them, so I was disappointed when Sorcha died and some others weren't mentioned anymore. In addition, I disliked that somehow all the women in Ren's realm suddenly seemed to be part of the Matrchi and they all knew of the other realities. That part was just unconvincing for me. At last, why have Fallon's stories all have to end with some sort of cliffhanger? Ok, this one was not as bad as the Tide Lord one, but I would have wished for a more closed ending.
