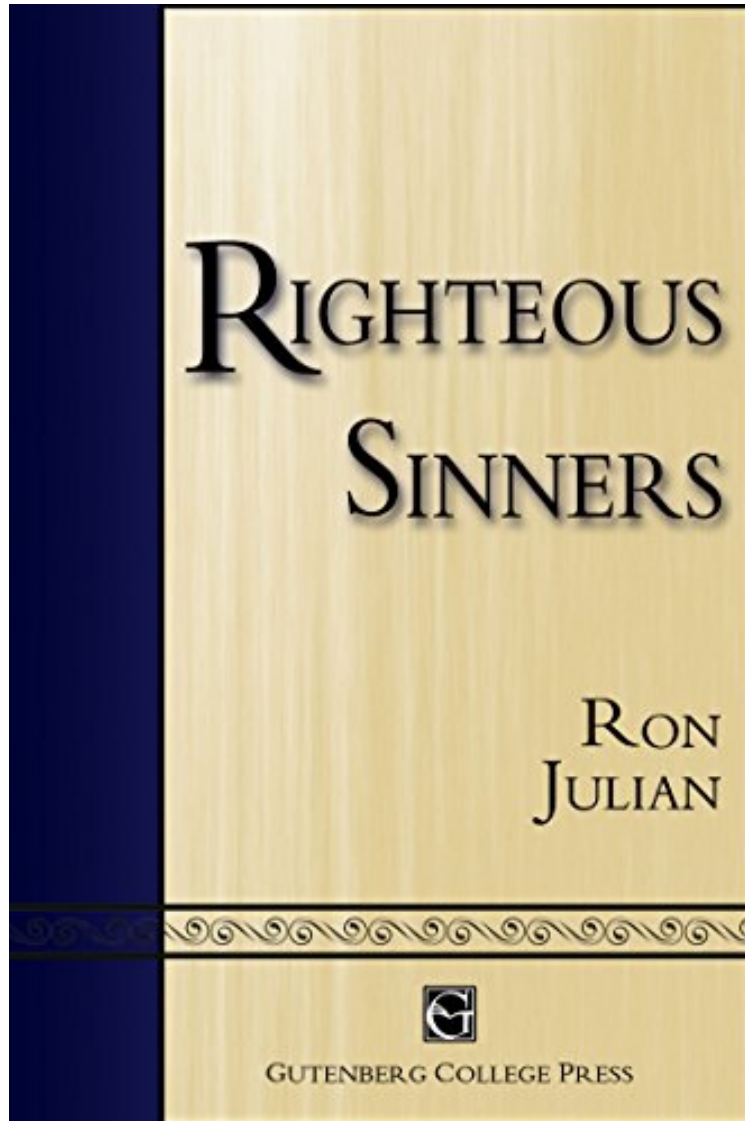

Mr. Julian is right on target in his belief that a christian will always struggle with sin. That is man's nature. If it were not, there would be no need for grace, and no need for Jesus. Where the book takes a wrong

turn, in my humble opinion, is on the subject of works. Mr. Julian says that you CANNOT earn salvation. It is available through faith and God's grace only. Curiously, he then goes on to say that you cannot have true faith without works. If you are saved and do not follow it up with works, then you are not truly saved to begin with. So, how much works does it take to prove to God (or as it seems to me Mr. Julian wants to prove it to other men) that you are saved? He says that God can see inside your heart. I agree 100%. However, if that is the case, then, we do not have to prove to God that we are saved by performing works. He already knows! My point is simply this: If we must perform works to prove that we are saved, is that not the same as earning salvation? According to the author, no works, no salvation. Thankfully, grace is free. I don't see God as a bookkeeper who is keeping track of what we do and don't do. If he sees us through Christ at the judgement, then we are sinless. If not, well not one of us will survive. Otherwise, we would have to determine how much of our time should be dedicated to works. 10%? 20%? Perhaps anything less than 100% is a sin, thus we are all in big trouble.
