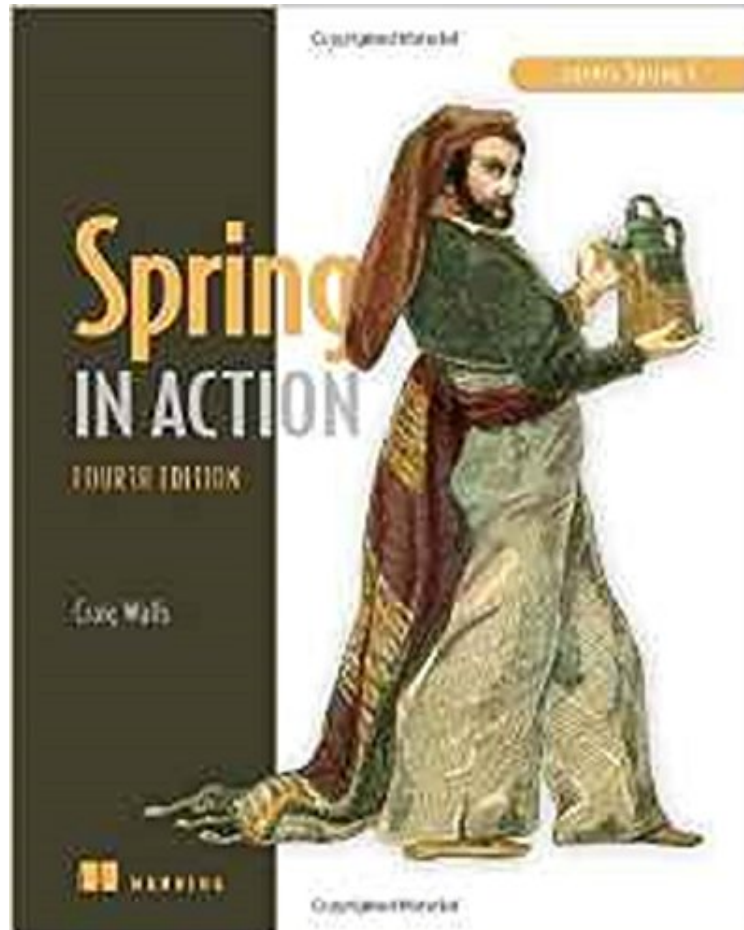

Source code is also available for download (and is necessary if you want to completely understand the examples in the book). In my opinion this book is useful for beginners as well as for advanced programmers. Beginners might need to look into some additional literature if they are not familiar with some of the technologies that build the basis (like servlets and JSPs), but this is something that just cannot be covered by a book that tries to teach you the basics of Spring. I bought the book because I was only familiar with Spring 2.5 (the book covers Spring 4) and wanted to get an update of what has changed in the meantime. And the book lived up to my expectations. What I don't like that much about the book are the examples. Those could be more coherent. The author starts with some medieval knights, princess and minstrel stuff and then jumps to CD/media-player and finally some sort of Twitter-like web-application. I would have preferred one theme that gets used for all the topics. Besides from that it's still a great book.
