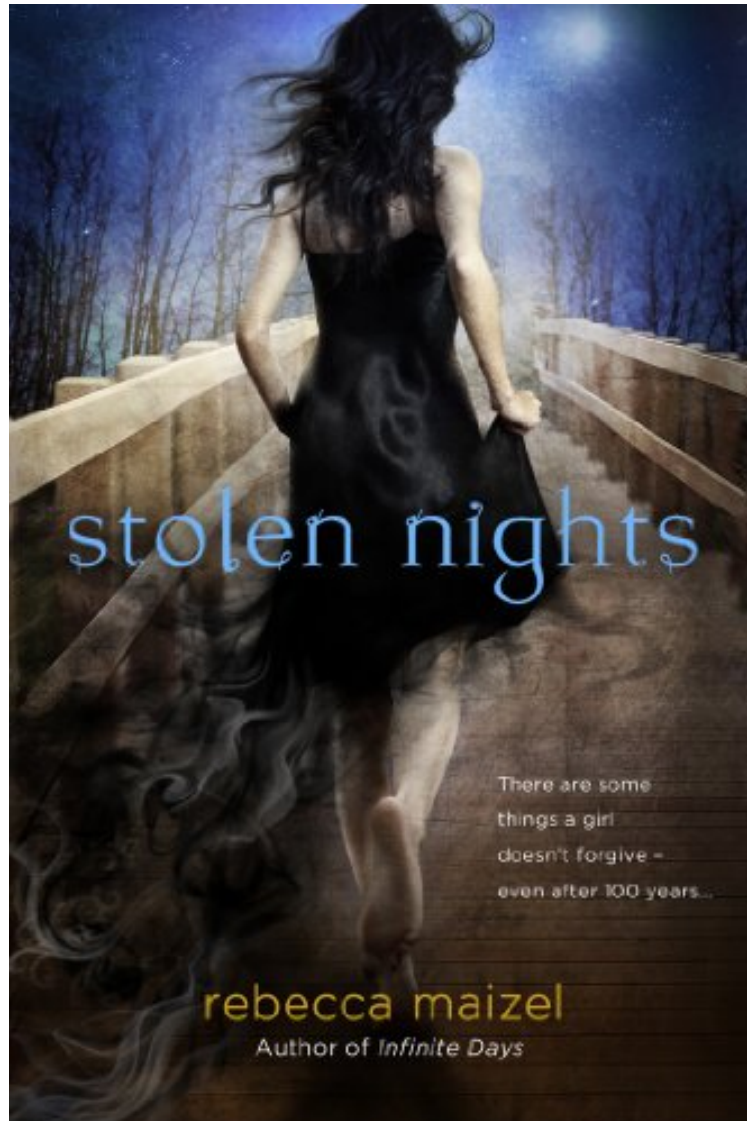

But many were also missing. So all in all, I was a bit disappointed and even annoyed and couldn't love it as much as the beginning of the Vampire Queen.Rebecca Maizel is definitely an amazing author. She can create this wonderful atmosphere, surprises with eloquent language

and presents us with characters that you simply have to love. I was intrigued by her mixture of past and present and by Lenah's task in the first book to become fully human. Now, in this book, we don't really have a grand mission anymore. Yes, there is a villain, but honestly I didn't think this person was very scary, not enough to carry the plot of the whole book. Lenah's mission was now firstly to reconcile with her past and bear the burden of her numerous murders. Secondly, she has to deal with Rhode's reappearance. Just as she (obviously) hasn't died while performing the ritual on Vicken, Rhode hasn't either. He has been human the whole time. As you can guess, there is now quite the confusion with Lenah, Rhode and Justin. Rhode is very cool and distant towards Lenah, and additionally Vicken is thrown into the picture. I was very glad that Vicken was there. He was such a humorous character with his Scottish charm and his deep loyalty. Fortunately, his bond with Lenah was broken with the ritual. He enjoys his human state to the fullest, is fascinated to see himself bleed or cry for the first time. Wonderful! I also loved the development of Tracy. She was a rather shallow girl in the first book, Justin's former girlfriend and member of the popular three-piece. But in this book, she becomes a fighter, fierce and protective of her school. I liked her a lot. But the problem is that the complete rest of the book only deals with Lenah and her own personal love problems. She doesn't know what to make of Rhode, Justin is also angry with her, and she can't just suck it up and be an independent woman. No, she can only contemplate how to get one of them, or better both, back. "Warmth, touch, tenderness - that was Justin. He was a reminder that I could truly be alive and feel love. He had helped me move on last year; I wanted him to help me now. Help me in the way only he could." "I mean, how egotistic is that?! I hate people who even contemplate using others and hurt their feelings meanwhile. That's just so wrong! The love story between Rhode and Lenah is epic with them being soulmates and all. We get to see lots of flashbacks of Lenah's past again. But I somehow couldn't get a connection to Rhode. As a reader I was too consumed with Lenah's mind, so it was hard to focus on other characters. I also wasn't satisfied with the ending. Of course, it's not the real end as there is supposed to be another book. But I couldn't find anything about its release. And the epilogue, well let me just say that I thought "No way! She can't be starting everything all over again". That was a final annoying bit of the plot. I really hope the last book will be better again because I still want to read it and see how the story ends.
