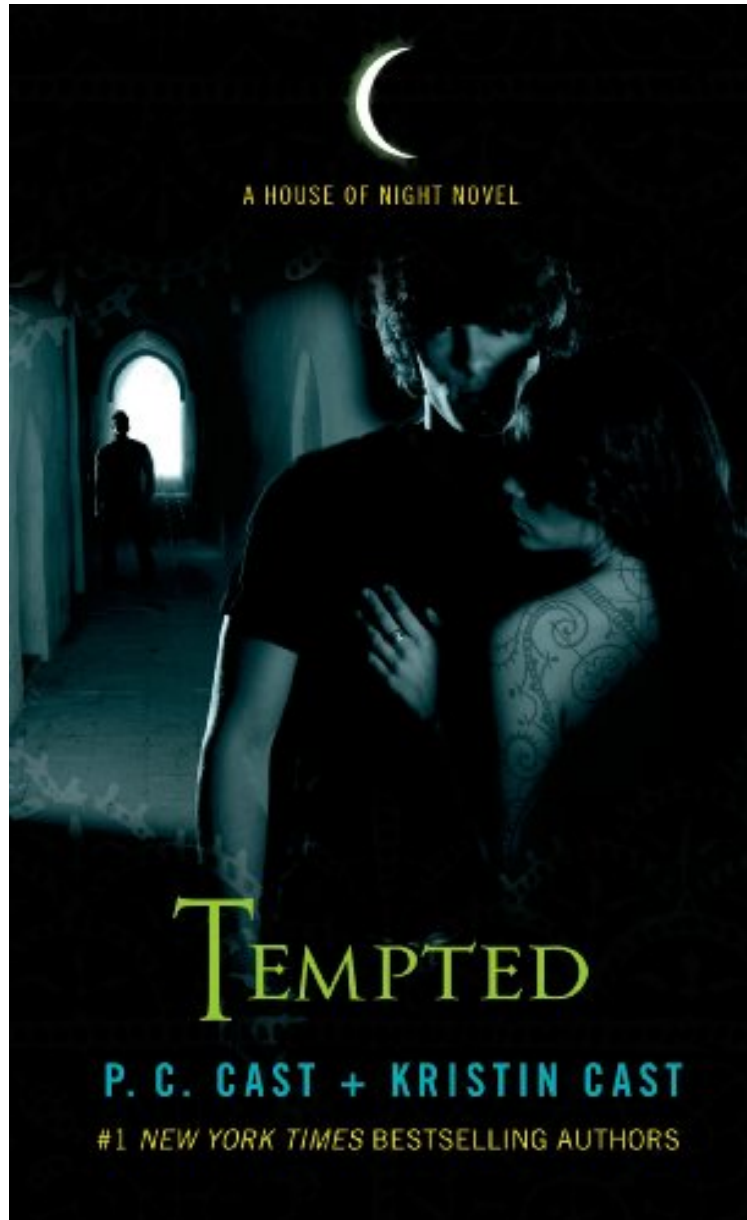

Monaten bestellt hatte) eintraf. Der letzte Teil hatte mich ein wenig enttäuscht. Die ewige Dreiecksbeziehung, die Abflachung der Spannung, Verlust der Glaubwürdigkeit. Trotzdem hatte ich die Hoffnung nicht aufgegeben und es hat sich ausgezahlt. *Tempted* betrifft den letzten Band definitiv. Zum einen bleiben die Perspektivwechsel stets spannend. Man regerte sich nicht mehr, wenn man gerade an einer spannenden Stelle bei Zoey unterbrochen wurde und stattdessen Steve Ray begleitete. Durch die Einföhrung eines neuen Charakters, der den ein oder anderen überraschen wird, wird ein neues Band in den Roman verflochten, das auch für weitere Romane Spannung verspricht. Zudem lernt man nun auch die Sichtweise der weniger Guten kennen. Denn nun erkennt man, dass Zoey's Gegner nicht alle abgrundtief böse sind, was mir persönlich sehr gefiel. Von Geheimnissen, Lügen und ihren Konsequenzen Von [sabatayn76](#) Inhalt: Zoey und ihre Freunde haben Kalona und Nefereet vertrieben und versuchen, sich von ihren Verletzungen und den Anstrengungen der letzten Tage zu erholen. Zoey ist jedoch wenig erleichtert: Einerseits plagen sie Albträume, in denen Kalona versucht, sie zu verführen und sie auf seine Seite zu ziehen, andererseits spürt sie, dass Stevie Rae Geheimnisse vor ihr hat und sie belügt. Mein Eindruck: *'Tempted'* ist düster und spannend. Kalona begleitet Zoey in ihren Träumen und ihren Gedanken und sorgt für viel Aufregung, Verwirrung und (Mit-) Bangen. Ich habe zudem das Gefühl, dass die Protagonisten - trotz der kurzen Zeitspanne, in der die Bücher spielen - viel erwachsener geworden sind, und dass auch die Autorinnen dazu gelernt haben und ihre Beschreibungen von Personen und Handlungen gereift sind. Das offene und unerwartete Ende hat mir sehr gut gefallen und ich bin sehr gespannt auf *'Burned'*. Allerdings sind mir einige (vermeidbare) Fehler aufgefallen, die bei einem gewissenhaften Korrekturlesen hätten bemerkt werden können: In Kapitel 26 haben die Autorinnen Zoey zuerst in dritter Person und dann als Ich-Erzähler zu Wort kommen lassen; kurz darauf verschließt Zoey eine Wunde mit Antikoagulantien, was jedoch die Blutgerinnung hemmen würde; die Autoren sprechen außerdem von *'Venetia'*, im Englischen spricht man jedoch entweder von *'Venice'* als Bezeichnung der Stadt oder von *'Venetian'* als Adjektiv, im Italienischen heißt die Stadt *'Venezia'*; weiterhin sind mir unzählige Kommatafehler aufgefallen. Mein Resümee: Ein spannendes Buch mit einem Ende, das Lust auf das nächste Buch der Reihe macht.

Ich war ja vom ersten Band her sehr begeistert, weil endlich mal wieder etwas im Buchhandel erschienen ist, das das Harry-Potter-Feeling wieder in mir hervorrief.
