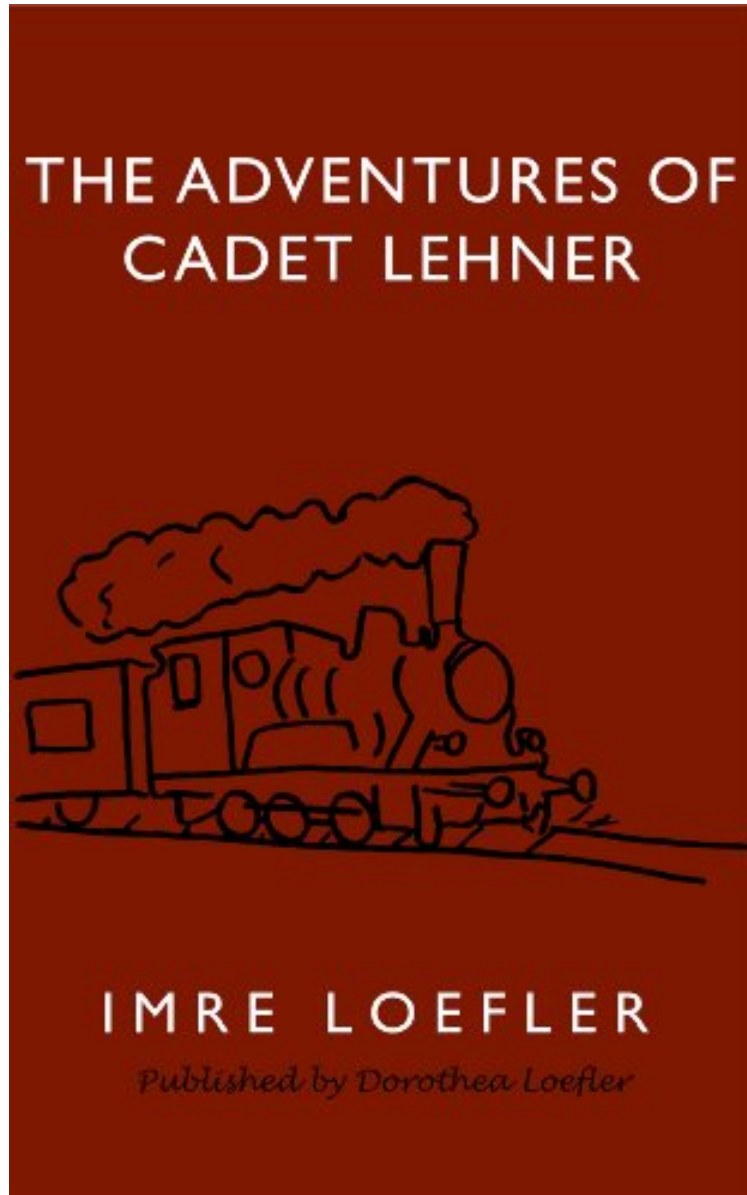

boring history books. Although the story partly takes place in the time of the Third Reich, this topic plays no significant role, but is merely the background for the adventures of the young cadet. The bigger part of the book however takes place in the early post-war Germany, an exciting period of time about which one learns only little in history lessons. At the beginning of the book you are introduced to the Hungarian society, an exotic journey, which tells you many interesting details concerning the family and the social background of the hero, but which demands also some patience from the reader. Soon however the story gathers pace and you willingly dive into all the small adventures and anecdotes that Paul is going to experience. In view of the fact that these stories were not written by a Hollywood-screenplay writer but are based on the experiences of the author himself, it is hard to believe that someone can go through so much in so little time and you admire the skills of the young cadet. The reason why this book never feels boring is firstly due to the ever-changing locations and secondly to Paul's tendency to disrespect rules and to grasp a chance when it presents itself whether this is about dealing on the black market, experiences with women or the first steps of his career as a surgeon. Because of the sheer length of the book the reader needs at least some endurance, but which is very well worth it in the end.
